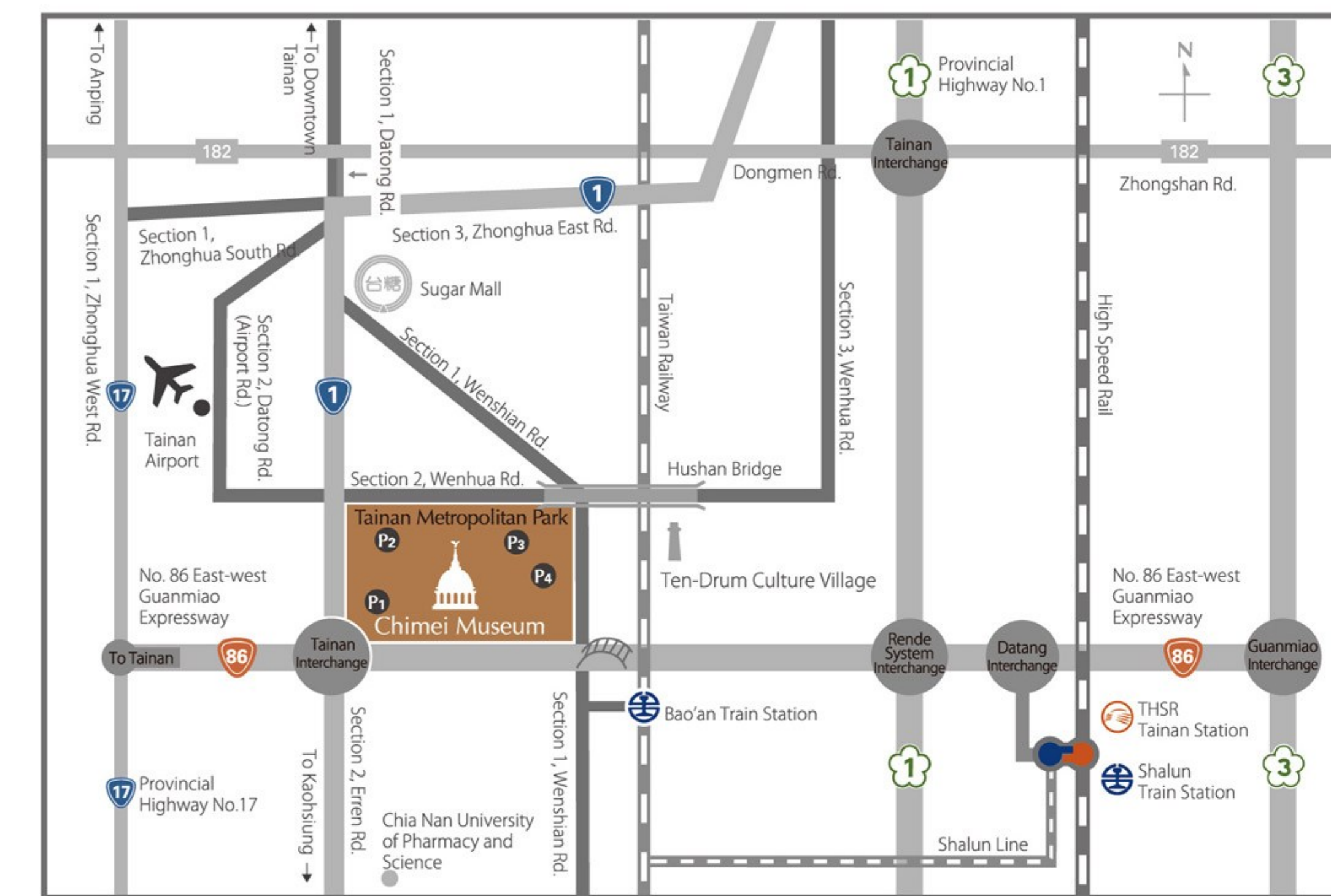
Plan Your Visit For a pleasant visit, please make sure to book reservation online in advance and purchase tickets upon arrival.

Other days announced by the Museum

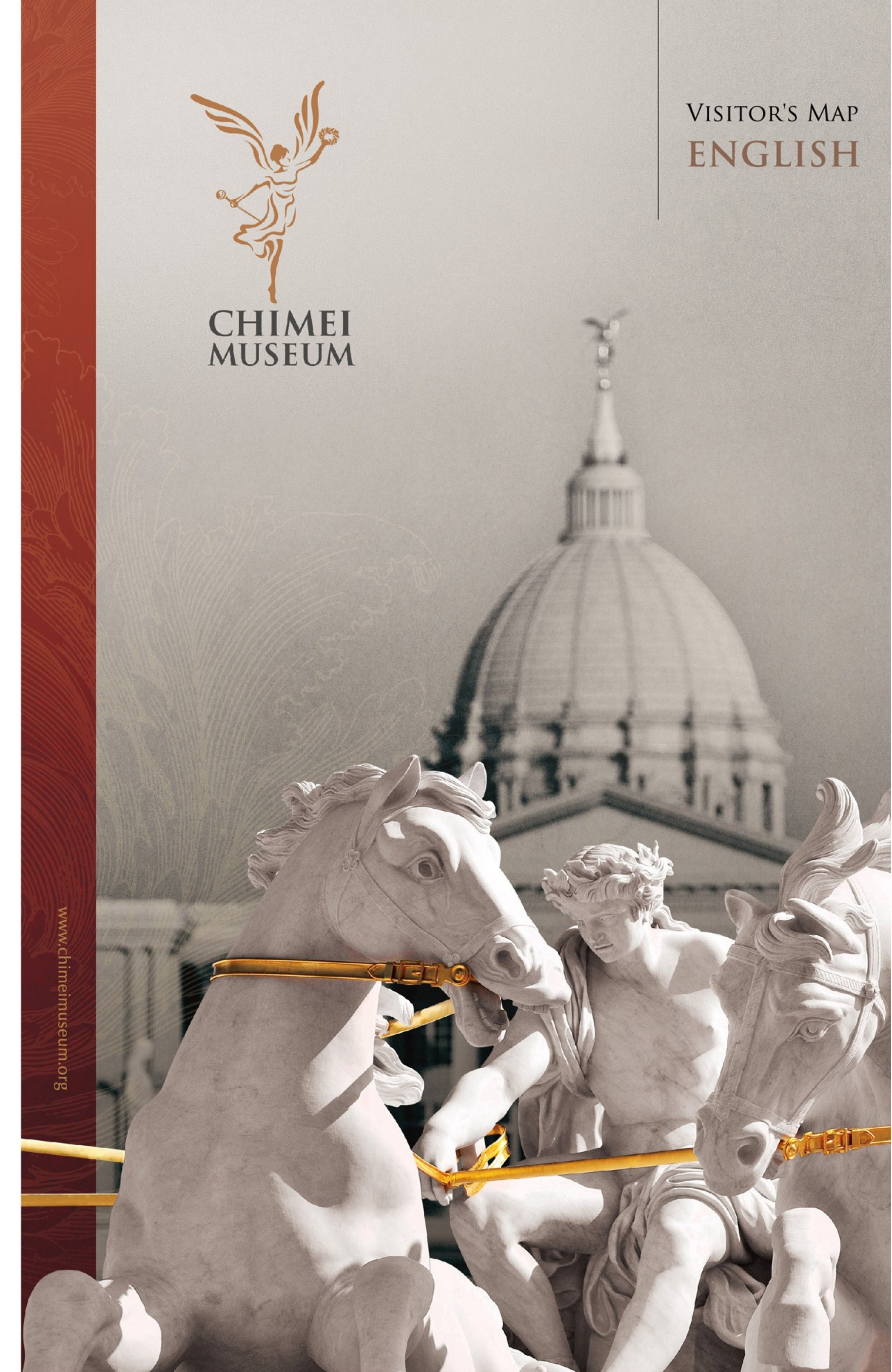
Tickets Adult ticket: NT\$200
Discount ticket: NT\$150 Available for school children, students, and senior citizens aged 65 and over.
Free admission Tainan City residents, children aged 6 and under, physically or mentally handicapped persons (plus one carer each), and students holding Tainan City Student ID.

- By car, on National Freeways**
Freeway No. 1 (Sun Yat-sen Freeway) or No. 3 (Formosa Freeway) onto Taiwan Provincial Expressway No. 86 (west to Tainan) continue for approximately 5 km connect onto Taiwan Provincial Highway No. 1 (to downtown Tainan) arriving Chimei Museum (Tainan Metropolitan Park).
- By car, on Provincial Highways**
Provincial Highway No. 1 (342 km marker) arriving Chimei Museum (Tainan Metropolitan Park).
- By train, Taiwan Railway Administration (TRA)**
Get off at Bao'an Station.
By bus: After exiting Bao'an Station, go to Bao'an Bus Station across from it, take bus Red 3 or Red 4 get off at the Tainan Metropolitan Park stop.
- By Taiwan High Speed Rail (THSR)**
Get off at Tainan Station.
(1) The taxi ride to Chimei Museum is approximately 15 minutes.
(2) Take HSR Shuttle Bus H31 (Tainan City Government route) get off at the Tainan Metropolitan Park stop.
(3) Transfer to Taiwan Railway TRA (Shulan Line to Bao'an Station), see 3.
- From airport**
From Tainan Airport take bus No. 5 or Red 3 get off at the Tainan Metropolitan Park stop (approximately 2 km from the airport).

Chimei Museum was first established in 1992 and is now located in the newly completed Tainan Metropolitan Park, operated by Chimei Museum Foundation. The Foundation officially obtained the operation right in 2013 for both Tainan Metropolitan Park and the Museum for 50 years.

In January 2015, Chimei Museum was open to the public with a brand new look. It is a museum with a variety of collections in such categories as Western arts, musical instruments, weaponry, and natural science specimens. A unique experience in the novelty of civilizations and in the beauty of arts can be discovered in exhibitions of Fine Art, Musical Instruments, Arms and Armour, Natural History and Fossils, Rodin Gallery, and the Sculpture Hall, as well as the Temporary Exhibition. As a museum for all, we sincerely invite every one of you to visit and explore.

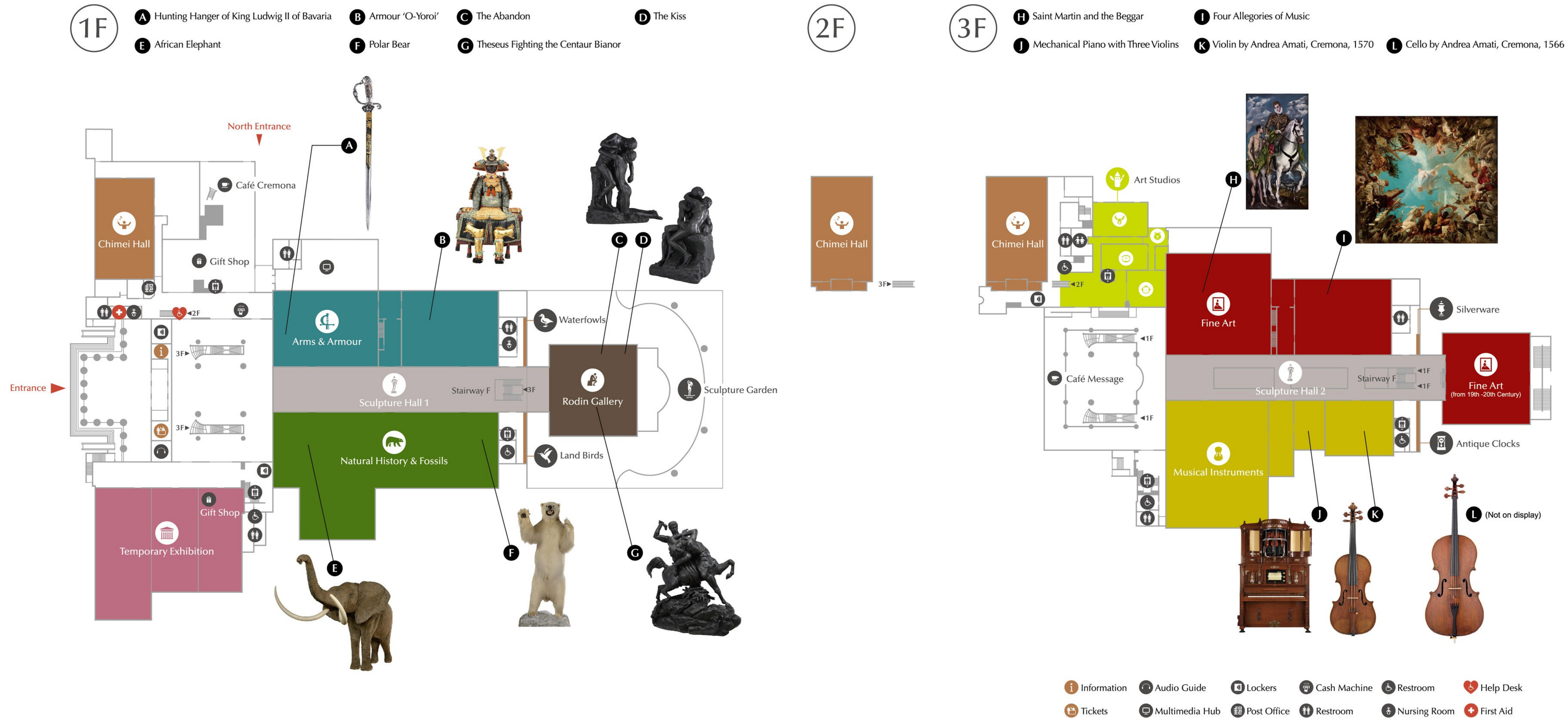
