


Quanmei Movie Theater + Movie Billboards No. 187, Sec. 2, Yongfu Road

This is the place that inspired world-famous director Ang Lee's movie dream. Quanmei Movie Theater is not only a movie theater but also a venue for theater and dance productions. It still uses traditional hand-painted movie billboards and hosts hand-painted movie billboard workshops as well.

Quanxing Tatami Straw Mats No. 46, Sinmei Road

The "national treasure" old master uses his extraordinary knife skills and hand sewing techniques to make tatami straw mats. So far he has made over 100,000 mats. Nowadays, Quanxing Tatami Straw Mats leverages its solid traditional techniques to develop customized cultural and creative products to promote "straw culture"



Former Baomei Restaurant No. 315, Sec. 2, Ximen Rd.

"Kang San Lau Restaurant in Taipei, Baomei Restaurant in Tainan" Before the 1970s, Baomei Restaurant was a major socializing venue for Tainan's prominent and wealthy figures. The famous song "Remembering Anping" also has connections to this restaurant - the lyricist Chen Da-ru was inspired by the love story between a local Anning girl and a Dutch ship doctor he heard here.

Tainan Wooden Clogs Store No. 318, Sec. 2, Ximen Rd.

Established during the late Qing dynasty, the store is currently run by the third and fourth

generations. Wooden clogs can be customized and are practical, sturdy, and fashionable as well. The wood absorbs water, offering good ventilation to prevent Athlete's foot. As long as the clog is not broken in half, it can be continuously worn, only the vamp needs to be changed. Guests can experience making their own clogs here.



Jin De Chun Tea House

Jin De Chun Tea House has a longer history than the Eternal Golden Fort. The large tea vats in the store are more than a hundred years old and bear witness to the store's transition through five generations. This old tea house insists on selling "tradition" and only sells aged teas and the best teas.



Longxing Galvanized Iron Store

No. 148, Sinmei Rd.

Galvanized iron sheets are more durable than general iron ones and do not rust. Longxing Galvanized Iron Store is an old traditional craft store that has been around for almost 60 years. The owner uses traditional methods to make galvanized iron pails and water sprin-



Jin Tong Cheng General Store

Starting from the intersection of Ximen and Minquan Road in the north, all the way south to Lane 228, Sec. 2, Ximen Road

A counterpart to Suehirochō, this main business street was located in the Honmachi zone (present Sec. 2, Minquan Road area) and was where the Taiwanese did business. Jin Tong Cheng was the name of the general store when it was opened by Qiu Tian-si during the Japanese Occupation Period. In 1940, he

built a row of townhouse storefronts which connected twenty buildings from the Honmachi triangle window to "Poop" Hill.




Chi Kan West House Restaurant
